

## The European cohesion policy

(ERDF, ESF, etc.) is the main investment and solidarity tool in the EU. Its aim is to reduce regional disparities, encourage innovation, generate growth and support sustainability on a regional scale as well as social integration. Defined at European level, the cohesion policy is implemented in and by the regions, in light of the challenges they and their populations face.

## The ERDF Operational Programme 2014-2020 in the Brussels Region

aims to concentrate these European resources on the development of economic, social and environmental challenges, with a particular focus on improving residents' quality of life. 58 projects and 3 financial instruments have been selected by the Brussels Government since May 2015, for a budget (ERDF+Region) of €195 million.






